## About Money Sorted in D2N2

Money Sorted in D2N2 provides support and personally tailored interventions for people experiencing the greatest financial difficulty. It can help you take control, build your confidence and skills and help you tackle barriers and problems in order to improve your financial well-being for the longer term.

## Who is it for?

Anyone who is experiencing financial difficulties and worries and would like some support. It is for people living in either Derby, Derbyshire, Nottingham or Nottinghamshire.

You need to be of working age and either unemployed or not in paid work at the time of starting.

## What does the project provide?

- ➔ A personal worker working with you (a 'Personal Navigator')
- ➔ Assessment of your financial well-being
- ➔ Personal action plan
- ➔ Help to improve your skills, knowledge and confidence with different money issues, (topics such as budgeting, banking, debt, credit, saving). This is tailored to your needs through one to one or group sessions.
- ➔ Option of a Money Mentor
- ➔ Support (or referrals) with your current financial circumstances, (such as benefit, debt, banking).
- ➔ Support getting into employment or training, if required.

## How is the project funded?

'Money Sorted in D2N2' is a three year project funded as part of the Building Better Opportunities programme in D2N2. The project is funded by the European Social Fund and the National Lottery, through the Big Lottery Fund.
